- Fish ponds










FIRST AID FOR NEAR DROWNING

Remove the victim from water



This must be done by a skilled person



In the absence of a skilled rescuer, shout for help



Shout for help



2. Lay the person on their back and perform chest compresions



Perform chest compressions



3. Perform rescue breathing



Rescue breathing




This is also referred to as a giving a kiss of life



Before giving a kiss of life, ensure that the airways are open

4.Call for a medical worker or take the victim to the hospital





PREVENTION OF NEAR DROWNING



Prevention of near drowning

- By wearing a life jacket when travelling on water.
- By putting lifeguards around swimming pools to supervise swimming
- By using a lifebelt where necessary
- By covering water tanks properly.
- By joining swimming classes to acquire swimming skills.
- Bathtubs should not be left with water.
- By fencing fish ponds.

Water tanks must be properly covered




