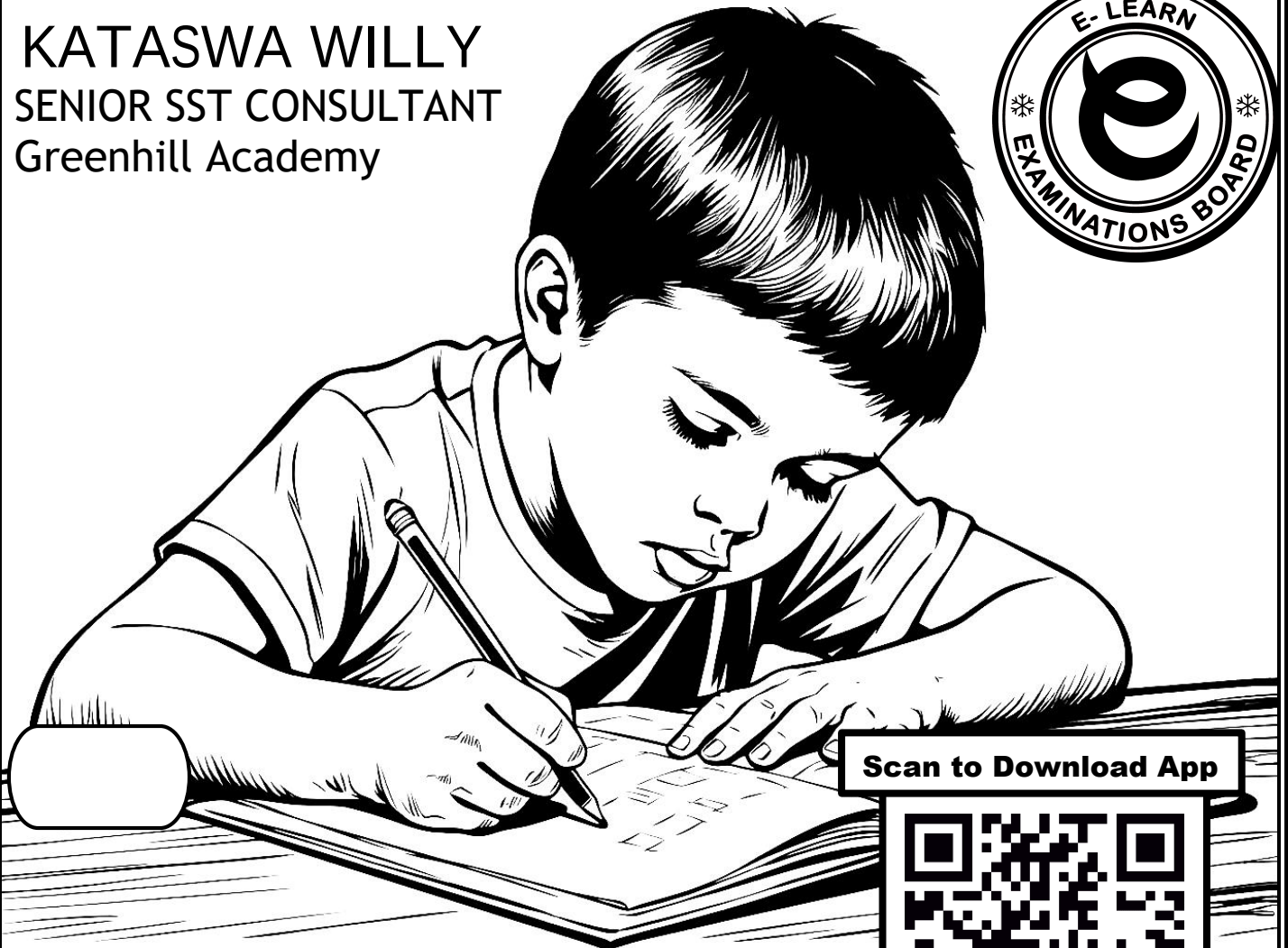

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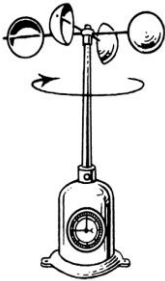

Monsoon winds helped to sail/drive/push the Arab dhows across the Indian Ocean
4. State **one** way in which the Northeast trade winds influence the climate of Africa.

6. How is a meteorologist able to measure the speed of wind on the weather instrument shown below.

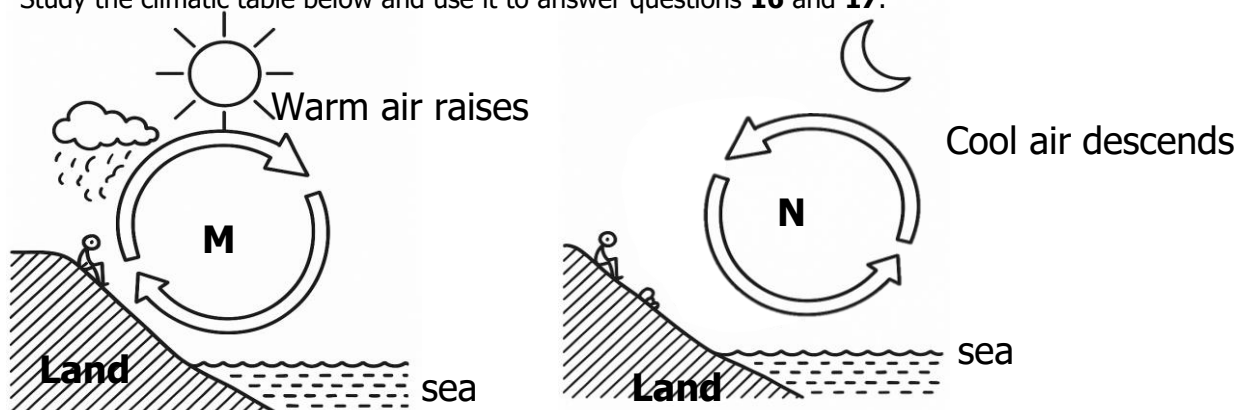


By reading the measuring scale

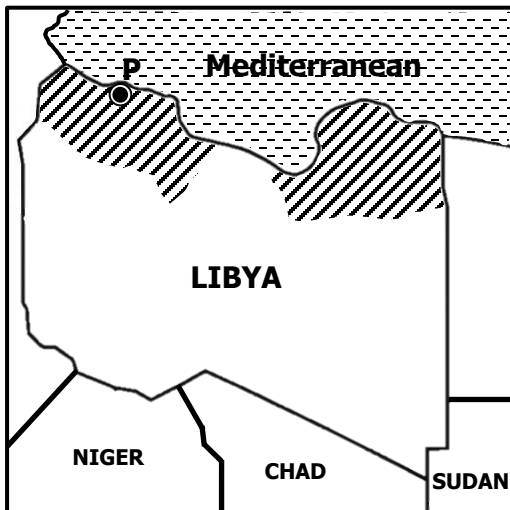
