Last Thursday, a fourteen year old Akiiki of Kabuuma Primary school in Wakiso district was thrown off the bicycle and sustained serious injuries when he crushed into a car at Kirudu-Salaama road. It was 7:00am and Akiiki was riding downhill towards his school. He was hurrying to get to his school for the first lesson which usually starts at 7:30am

A car infront of him slowed down and Akiiki thought that it was going to stop. He wanted to ride past the car. So, he rode faster. Unfortunately, the car turned left infront of him and it was too late to stop. He hit the back of the car with a strong bang that bounced him in the middle of the road. When the driver heard the bang, he looked in the side mirror and saw a

boy bouncing in the middle of the road. He immediately parked his car. The motorcyclist who was riding towards them stopped and pulled the boy out of the road. Akiiki survived death but he sustained severe injuries on the face, legs and shoulders.

The driver rushed him to Kirudu hospital immediately to get treatment. The traffic police officer arrived later and asked the observers how the accident occurred. The driver of the car was taken to police to make a statement and then the head teacher of Akiiki was informed and was asked to call the parents of Akiiki to go and meet him in the hospital.
