Item 1. Map skills

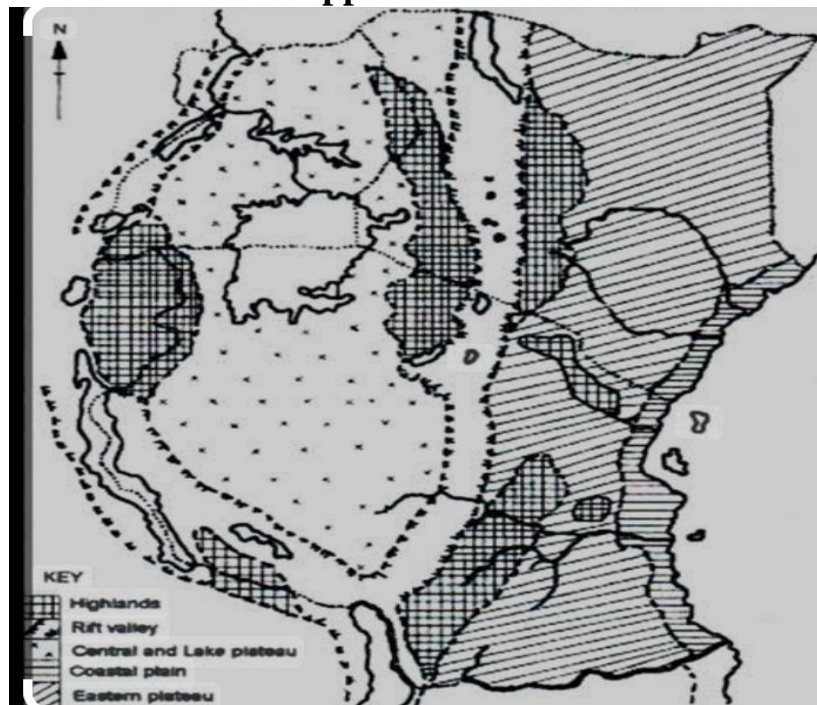

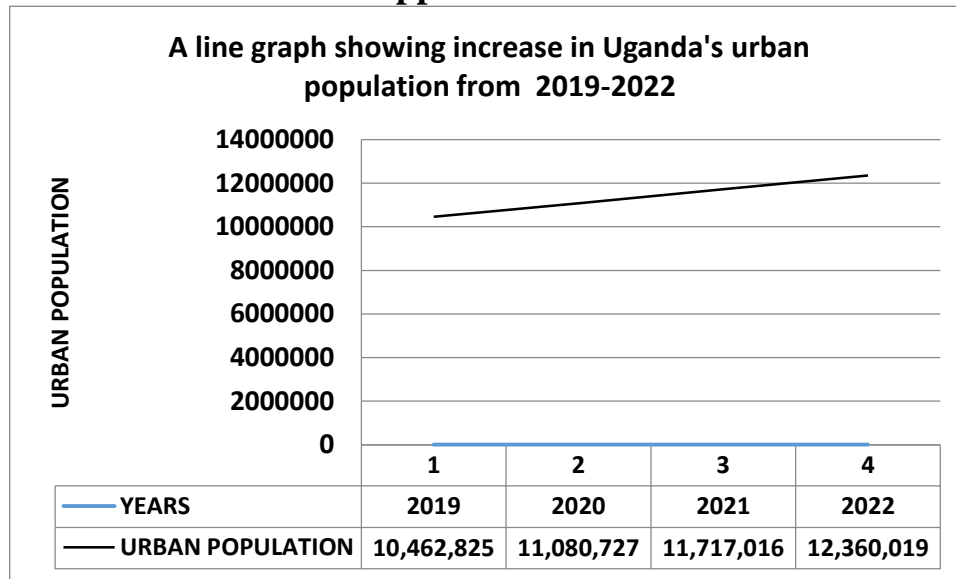
